LOUDOUN REPUBLICANS UNITE AT MASS MEETING

Caroline elected Chairman, LCRC, 10TH District and RPV Delegates set

Leesburg, Va. (March 15, 2008) –Loudoun County Republicans gathered in great numbers today at the Loudoun County Republican Mass Meeting held at Leesburg's Heritage High School in their regular reformation of the Loudoun County Republican Committee. One of the main matters at hand was the election of Glen Caroline as the LCRC's new Chairman.

"There comes a time when adversity and opportunity intersect and one is forced to make a choice. For the LCRC, we can choose stagnation and regression, or seize the opportunity to move forward toward victory," Chairman Caroline stated. "We will choose the path of victory."

He continued: "I pledge to you I will conduct LCRC affairs in a fair, open, dignified, and respectful manner. We will welcome and encourage spirited and rigorous debate. But it will be conducted in a fair, respectful and dignified manner. And at end of the day, after debate, we must all come together to focus on accomplishing our mutual goals."

Caroline takes the reigns from former Chairman Paul Protic, who had lead the committee since 2006. Caroline has been involved with the LCRC since 2002 and has previously served on the Executive Committee and as the Dulles District Chairman. He has been involved in several local, state and federal campaigns for such candidates as Gary Clemens, Frank Wolf, Mark Earley and Oliver North.

Additionally critical business at the Mass Meeting included the election of up to 1,760 delegates for both the 10th District Republican convention, scheduled on May 17 at Langley High School, and the Republican Party of Virginia convention, scheduled for May 30 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center. Caroline concluded, "My three priorities are increasing LCRC membership, getting back to grassroots basics, and keeping the White House, the Virginia Senate seat, and the 10th district seat in Republican hands. As a unified local party, we must get back to focusing on the 98% of issues on which we are united, not on the 2% that may divide us. During my campaign, I pledged unity, principle, and victory. I believe if we are united and stick by our principles, victory will follow"
